3. Yes it's viable BUT...



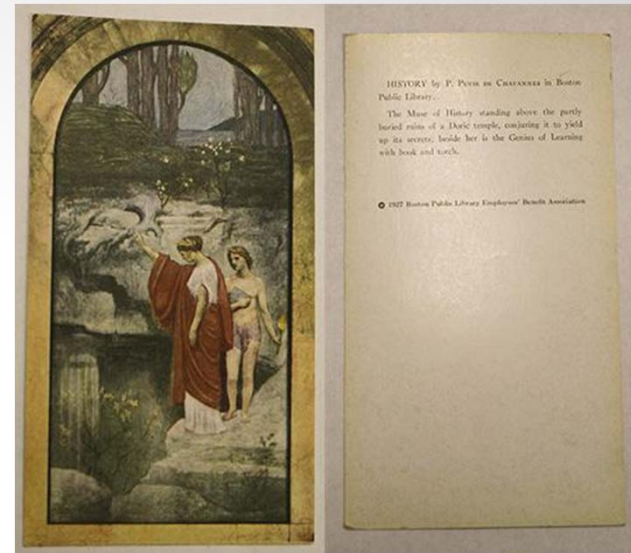
Sample Metadata Record. See 'Metadata Guidelines' document for details on each field (see note). Printer and Publisher guides are also available through the links in the notes.

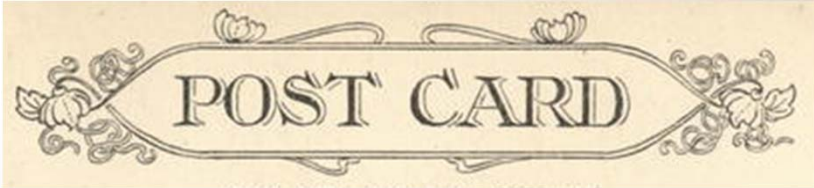
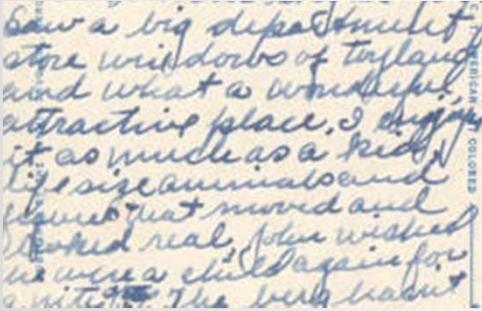

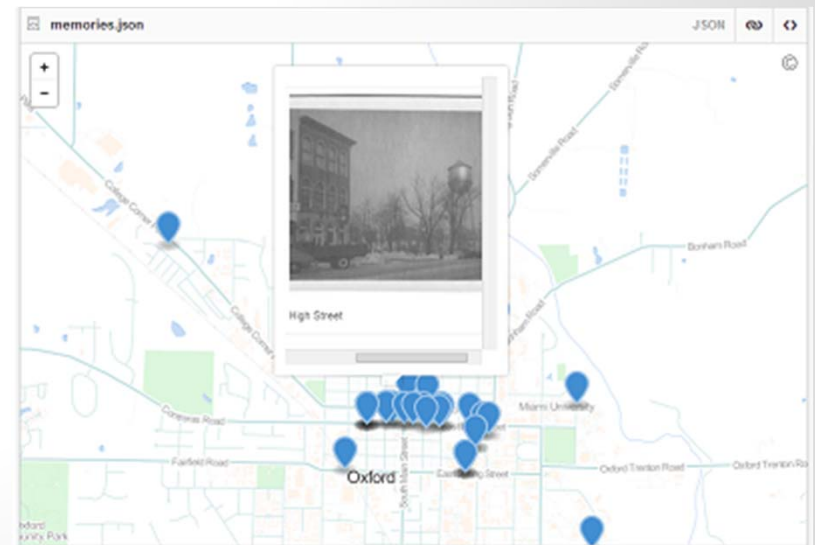
