#### WHAT IS A SYSTEMATIC REVIEW?

A comprehensive collection and appraisal of all evidence on a well-defined topic using standardized methods and tools to synthesize and transparently report conclusions

Reduce Bias

Improve reliability & validity

### **DEFINITION: SYSTEMATIC REVIEW**

- Answer <u>narrowly-defined</u> research question
  - PICO
- Comprehensive collection & appraisal of <u>all</u> evidence
  - Peer-reviewed & grey literature
- <u>Documented</u>, <u>transparent</u>, <u>reproducible</u> methods
  - Plan
  - Search
  - Screen / Appraise
  - Synthesize & Report


